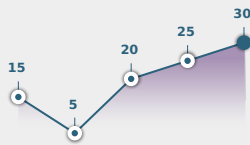

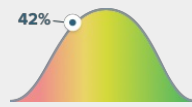

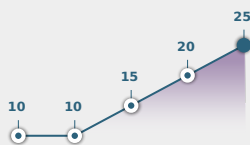
Response Inhibition refers to the ability to concentrate on relevant information in order to make a correct response despite interference or distracting information.

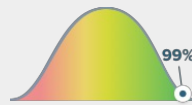

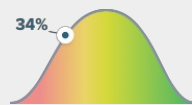

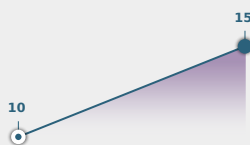
Planning refers to the ability to act with forethought and sequence behaviour in an orderly fashion to reach specific goals.

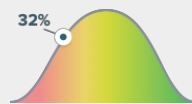

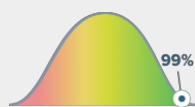
